It was agreed that concerning the 20th meeting, they shall be sent to the former President Mr Van Dijk in order to be corrected.

5. Report of the Working Group of the new membership

6. Final Decision for the 15th WCNDT, and candidates for next Conferences

Mr Romero (Spain) stated that he doesn't want a confrontation, so Spain withdraws and will be the candidate for the 16th WCNDT Meeting.

Italy was chosen to hold the 2000 WCNDT Meeting. Prof. Nardoni is honoured to host this meeting and thanked all delegates for their help and contribution.

7. Report of the Working Group on Qualification and Certification of NDT Personnel

Prof. Pawlowski presented a report of W.G. on Harmonisation of Training and Qualification of NDT Personnel, attached. All the conclusions were accepted by the Committee.

8. Report of the Working Group on ICNDT Policy and Terms of Reference

Prof. Pawlowski presented a proposal on behalf of the Working Group (attached). The four items were discussed and approved in total.

Concerning item 2 of the report, the following people were assigned to form a Policy and General Purposes Committee:

Proposed by Prof. De Meester, it was agreed to form four permanent Working Groups as follows:

- 1. Certification and Strategy Working Group
- 2. World Conference Technical Program Working Group
- 3. Training Program Working Group
- 4. Information Working Group

9. Information on the 14th WCNDT

Mr Sampath stated that the 14th WCNDT/ICNDT President shall be Dr Baldev Raj. The other officers shall be appointed in the very near future.

10. Miscellaneous

Mr Sonneveld (Australia) proposed that ICNDT encourage the societies/associations/institutes of member countries to use the symbol or statement "A member of the International Committee of Nondestructive Testing" on stationery and letterheads in order to advertise and promote ICNDT.

The meeting endorsed the proposal unanimously, however there is no officieal logo/symbol at present.

ABENDE copied the symbol established for the Amsterdam Conference and Indian representatives indicated their intention to modify the symbol by rotating the world to illustrate the Asian countries.

Mr Hayes presented a video about the 6th European Conference to be held in Nice, France.,

The President and the Brazilian non-voting delegate were honoured to receive gifts from the Indian delegation.

11. Adjournment

The President Hallai thanked all the attendants and stated that Brazil was honoured for holding the 22nd ICNDT Meeting.
