1. Scope

Procedure covers the approval prior to publication of all official ICNDT publications, i.e. publications carrying the name and endorsement of ICNDT. Separate Procedures apply for the ICNDT Journal and Website.

2. Editorial Committee

The IEC shall nominate the Editorial Committee for each Publication that is agreed with membership as defined below:

- Chair of ICNDT or Immediate Past Chair;
- ii. One person from each Regional Group wishing to participate;
- iii. Additional members (who may be chosen for their knowledge relevant to specific proposed publications).

3. Method of Working

- 3.1 Communications between the originator(s) of an official publication the nominated Editorial Committee shall be by e-mail.
- 3.2 The draft version(s) and final version of the publication shall be circulated to the full editorial committee for comment, using the attached proforma.
- 3.3 The final version of the publication shall be approved by the Editorial Committee.

6. Reference to IEC

If the Editorial Committee is unable to unanimously approve a publication the matter shall be referred to the IEC.

7. Records

Records of comments, resultant actions and approvals shall be retained by the individual preparing the publication.
